This revision, consisting of a title sheet, title block, studies, official actions taken with respect to the plat, and the following general description of the farm unit boundaries, comprises the first revision of the farm unit plat of Irrigation Block 2, of the Columbia Basin Project, dated January 14, 1934, and filed for record in the County Auditor's Office of Walla Walla County, Washington, on October 17, 1934, Auditor's file No. 300057. Previous revisions were filed on plats filed on April 9, 1933, July 26, 1934, August 21, 1937, and August 3, 1939.

In considering this revision, investigations and studies were made of the lands in the block and the project as a whole with the object of determining the quality, character, boundaries of the various farm units in this block, having in mind the requirements of the various water project Act 1907, Act 1917, and of the regulatory laws of September 1933, as amended, and of the policies established thereunder by the Secretary of the Interior. In view of these studies and investigations and all relevant data brought before you under the filing of the farm unit plat, I find that the quality as herein shown, except those portions not to be used for farming, are of sufficient quality for the support of an overpopulated family at a suitable living level, and have appropriate values and boundaries. Having ascertained the character of the soil, topography, location with respect to the irrigation system, and all other factors that are relevant to the determination of the areas and boundaries of the farm units, and, based on these studies and investigations, I find that there exists in the area a need for units of land that are of suitable quality land for extensive farming purposes, and to meet this need, I have outlined the tentative farm units as herein shown. Accordingly, action is taken in the certificate submitted to the Commissioner of Reclamation in the Secretary of the Interior, as shown in Departmental Order 1934, dated July 26, 1934, and Departmental Order 1934, dated August 21, 1934, all as recorded in the Auditor's Office of Walla Walla County, Washington, in which the Columbia Basin Project at page 20, and was sent to the provisions of the Columbia Basin Project Act as amended, and the regulatory laws of September 1933, as amended, and the permanent contract of October 9, 1934, as amended, between the United States of

America and the South Columbia Basin Irrigation District, I hereby revise the farm unit plat of Irrigation Block 2, dated January 14, 1934, as revised, by publishing the general description of that plat with the General Instructions of this plat.
