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This acreage tabulation is based on the ten-year irrigable area survey, which becomes effective at the beginning of the first year of the construction repayment period for the block (January 1, 1972).

1--All units, unless designated otherwise, are farm units. A farm unit is a unit of land platted prior to October 1, 1962, as then referred to in the Columbia Basin Project Act.

2/--Miscellaneous water delivery unit--A unit, irrespective of ownership, containing land which was added to the block after October 1, 1962.

3/--Land in Class 6 is regarded as nonirrigable.

4--Land designated as high is land which, although arable, is classified as nonirrigable because of higher elevation or location with respect to the turnout and measuring device provided for delivery of water from the Project irrigation system.

*--Includes area under high land contract.

#--Includes land having potential seepage problems for which construction of drainage works is not economically feasible, as evidenced by recorded agreement.

A--Unit in Adams County.
