


Grand Coulee Dam Visitor Center Hours of Operation




The Grand Coulee Dam Visitor Center is open daily from 8:30 a.m.–5 p.m. Pacific Time. The visitor center is closed on the following federal holidays: Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Year's Day.

The "One River, Many Voices" laser light show begins May 26, 2023. It runs nightly at 10:00 p.m. through July 31. Beginning Aug. 1, the laser light show will start at 9:30 p.m., and beginning Sept. 1–30, it will start at 8:30 p.m. Start times are subject to change. Tickets are not required to watch the light show. Admission is free. The laser light show ends for the year on Sept. 30 and will resume in May 2024.

John W. Keys III Pump-Generating Plant Guided Tour



Public tours begin May 26, 2023. Tours are available on a first-come, first-served basis at 9 a.m., 11 a.m., 1:30 p.m., and 3:30 p.m. Pacific Time, running approximately one hour. Public tours end for the year Oct. 31 and will resume in May 2024. **Tour availability will be limited.** Admission is free.

The tour begins at the tour parking lot on the east side of the dam where you will board a bus and be taken to the pump-generating plant. The tour concludes with a bus ride over top of the dam.

All tour participants are required to pass through a metal detector prior to beginning the tour. Attendees may bring cameras on the tour, but all camera cases must remain in vehicles. Onsite storage for personal belongings is unavailable. The following items are prohibited on tour:

- Weapons
- Backpacks/fanny packs
- Purses/bags
- Packages
