

## Hungry Horse Dam Visitor Center Hours of Operation and Outdoor Guided Walking Tour




The visitor center is open daily from 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. MDT. Visitors can enjoy exhibits that highlight Hungry Horse's history and its role in flood control and recreation in Flathead County. Learn about the dam's contribution to hydroelectric power generation on the Columbia River. Admission is free.

Enjoy a walk along the length of the dam, or take a guided tour with a Reclamation guide to learn about the gantry crane, water tower, old cableway location, and the highest morning glory spillway in the world.

## **Hungry Horse Dam**



The outdoor guided walking tour is 1.5 miles and takes approximately one hour. Admission is free.

New in 2022 is the ability to reserve a spot for the 9 a.m. MDT tour. Tours are available up to four times daily, pending staffing availability. Except for the 9 a.m. tour, tours are on a first-come, first-served basis, and visitors must sign up at the visitor center front desk. All tours are limited to a maximum of 12 attendees per tour and are subject to change and can be canceled without notice.
