Subject: 2025 Upper Snake River and Reservoir Operations Update

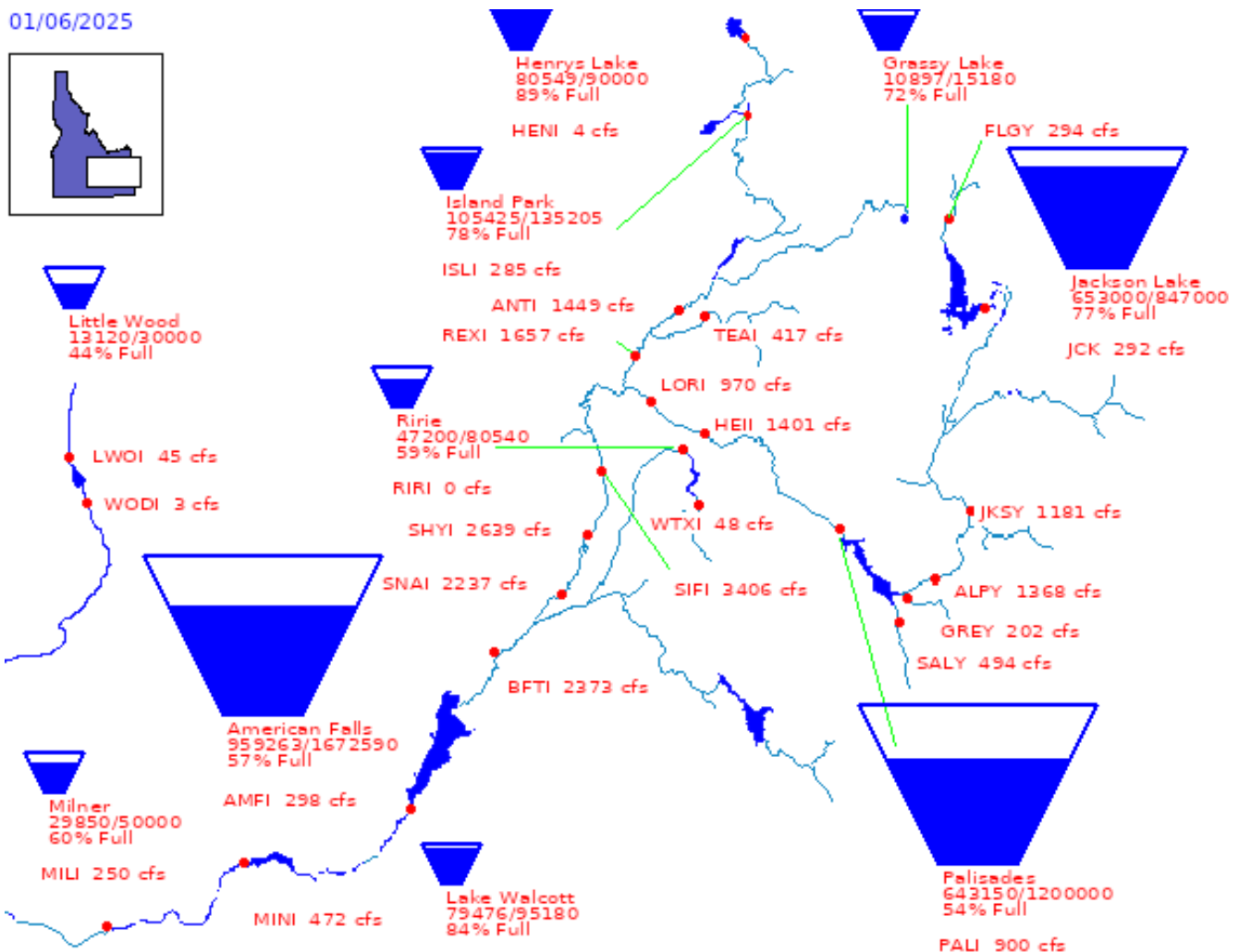
Purpose: The purpose of these updates is to provide information regarding Reclamation's operations and basin conditions as the season progresses. The information is provisional and subject to change.

Total System Update: The reservoir system is currently 62% full, which is approximately 104% of the 1991-2020 median for the date.
