Subject: 2023 Upper Snake River and Reservoir Operations Update

Purpose: The purpose of these updates is to provide information regarding Reclamation's operations and basin conditions as the season progresses. The information is provisional and subject to change.

Highlights

*Beginning Friday, September 15th, Lake Walcott levels will be reduced

Total System Update: The reservoir system is 49% full, which is approximately 109% of median for the date and 1,258,197 acre-feet higher than a year ago.

Jackson Lake: Releases from Jackson Lake Dam will continue to be adjusted as needed to achieve reservoir level targets and objectives. At this time, it is anticipated that releases will be incrementally reduced to initial storage season flows by October 2nd. There is a public meeting in Jackson on September 14th where Reclamation staff will present a 101-level overview of the Upper Snake System. Please see the following link for more information - Link.

*Lake Walcott: USFWS submitted a request to draft Lake Walcott by 2-3' this fall for the purpose of facilitating prescribed burns and shoreline maintenance on the wildlife refuge. Similar operations have been conducted at Lake Walcott for various purposes, including as recently as last year. The draft of Lake Walcott is achieved via reduced releases from upstream reservoirs (American Falls) while maintaining water delivery at and below Minidoka Dam. The operation will begin later this week with an initial 2' draft of Lake Walcott and, when conditions permit, an additional 1' draft by early October.
