Subject: Water Year 2026 Upper Snake River and Reservoir Operations Update

Purpose: The purpose of these updates is to provide information regarding Reclamation's operations and basin conditions as the season progresses. The information is provisional and subject to change.

Overall storage conditions

Upper Snake River system: 47% full, which is approximately 80% of the 1991-2020 median for today's date.

Little Wood Reservoir: 49% full, which is approximately 103% of the 1991-2020 median for today's date.
