Article 31: Contract Drafting Considerations (Standard Article 31), for the benefit of supporting general policy and specific requirements set

forth in Reclamation Manual Policy, Reclamation Standard

Water-Related Contract Articles (PEC P10).

Authority: The Reclamation Act of 1902 (ch. 1093, 32 Stat. 388), and acts

amendatory and supplementary thereto

- 1. **Introduction.** The first sentence of Standard Article 31 is required in all contracts, directly or by reference (see Paragraph 4.B. of PEC P10). It affirms that the parties were competent to and did participate in the formation of the contract. The second sentence of Standard Article 31 is required in all contracts that have provisions with negotiable terms. It affirms that the parties participated in drafting the articles that have negotiable provisions.
- 2. **Applicability.** This Directive and Standard applies to Bureau of Reclamation staff and officials involved in the contracting process, as defined at Paragraph 5.A. of PEC P10.
- 3. **Requirements and Responsibilities.** Reclamation staff and officials involved in the contracting process will include the text below in all contracts requiring Standard Article 31 under Paragraph 4.B. of PEC P10.

CONTRACT DRAFTING CONSIDERATIONS¹

This Contract has been negotiated and reviewed by the parties hereto, each of whom is sophisticated in the matters to which this Contract pertains. Articles _ through _ of this Contract have been drafted, negotiated, and reviewed by the parties, and no one party shall be considered to have drafted the stated articles.²

- 4. **Definitions.** See Paragraph 5 of PEC P10.
- 5. **Review Period.** The originating office will review this release every 4 years.
