




## Agreements since 1996 – Total 248

In over two decades: ~\$78 million in research projects

In 2019: ~\$12 million across 37 new projects

## Additional Reclamation Desal / Reuse Funding

- Title XVI Water Reuse Research \$1.5M FY16 and FY17. Funding Opportunity in FY19 with \$3M available – currently in process.
- WIIN Act Title XVI \$50M total FY17 through FY19 appropriated for construction of Title XVI projects eligible under the WIIN Act amendments to the Title XVI Program.
- Title XVI Since 1992, more than \$745 million in federal funding has been awarded to Congressionally authorized projects through the Title XVI Program and is being leveraged with non-Federal funding to implement more than \$3.4 billion in water reclamation and reuse improvements.
- WIIN Act Desalination Construction \$30M total FY17 through FY19 appropriated for construction of ocean and brackish water desalination projects under the WIIN Act amendment to the Desalination Act of 1996.
