Subject: Fiscal Year (FY) 2026 Rates and Projected FY 2027 Rates for Technical Service

Center (TSC) Work

I am happy to be able to share some updated information prior to the start of the new fiscal year. Attached are the final FY 2026 TSC base billable labor rates, premium rates, and fees for unique services, interagency agreements, and interns. While these reflect a 26 percent (%) increase over FY 2025 due to rising indirect costs, they are reduced from the 33% increase initially shared on September 2, 2025. This reduction is based on the latest guidance from Reclamation's Assessment Rate Group (ARG) and provides some relief to the TSC client base from the original projections.

The TSC's Customer Review Board (CRB), representing most Reclamation clients, has been briefed and acknowledges the impact on project budgets and scope. The primary driver remains changes to Departmental (IIC), Bureau-wide (BIC), and Regional (RIC) indirect costs—external factors assessed through labor surcharges and beyond our control.

Despite these challenges, the TSC is committed to cost management and minimizing the financial burden on our clients. For FY 2026, we have reduced internal costs by lowering overhead allocations for management and training and cutting capitalized equipment expenses.

The FY 2026 base billable rates are shown in the table below.

Service agreements in the Electronic Service Agreement Module (ESAM) with FY 2026 budgets already in place at the time of this labor rate update have been automatically adjusted to reflect the new rates. For direct charge agreements, this adjustment will result in an increased FY 2026 budget for the agreement scope. For funding agreements and agreements with other government agencies, staff days have been reduced to remain within the approved budget.

If either of these approaches do not align with your needs, please coordinate with your TSC Team Lead to determine the appropriate path forward and if a change order is needed.

Depending on the circumstances, these may include:

- an increase in funding to cover the higher rates (if additional funds are available),
- an extension of the project into the following fiscal year (if future-year funding is anticipated), or
- a reduction in scope to align with the existing budget.

TSC Team Leads should coordinate closely with their clients to determine the most appropriate course of action and initiate any required change orders to ensure project goals can still be met.

We sincerely appreciate your continued partnership and the strong support reflected in our current and projected workload.
