Subject: Finding of No Significant Impact for the Davis and Weber Counties Canal Company Improvement Project, Davis County, Utah

In compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and the Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) and Department of the Interior (DOI) regulations implementing NEPA, the Bureau of Reclamation, Provo Area Office (Reclamation) completed an environmental assessment (EA) to determine the effects of using Federal funds authorized by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA), to make improvements to a canal system. On December 21, 2009, we sent a copy of this EA to you for your information and review.

The comment period for this EA ended on Friday, January 8, 2010, and after reviewing the EA and the one comment received, I have determined that a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) is appropriate for this proposed action. A copy of the signed FONSI is enclosed for your information.

The FONSI authorizes the Davis and Weber Counties Canal Company (DWCCC) to use Federal funds to replace a deteriorating canal liner, the canal headworks in the Weber River, the forebay channel and associated gates. The purpose of the proposed improvements is to conserve water, increase availability of water, increase the efficiency of the existing facilities, and replace deteriorated facilities before they can no longer function. The project is located in Davis County, Utah.
