<p>Page 5 of 41:</p> <p><b>Goal 1.</b> Protect or improve the aquatic foodbase so that it will <b>support viable populations of desired species</b> at higher trophic levels.</p>	<p>The target for all the Management Objectives in Goal 1 is adequate food availability to <b>support trout and native fish</b> above the Paria River, and native fish below the Paria River.</p>
<p>Page 10 of 41:</p> <p><b>Goal 3.</b> Restore populations of extirpated species <b>as feasible and advisable.</b></p>	<p>"...<b>as feasible and advisable.</b>"</p>
<p>Page 11 of 41:</p> <p><b>Goal 4.</b> Maintain a wild reproducing population of rainbow trout above the Paria River, to the extent practicable and <b>consistent with the maintenance of viable populations of native fish.</b></p>	<p>NOTE FOR GOAL 4: The purpose of this goal is recreation. It is limited by MO 2.6: "The target is reduction of non-native fish predation so it does <b>not impinge on native fish viability.</b>"</p>
