Science Advisors Program in TWP

- Science Advisors Program is administered by Reclamation
 - C. Program Administration, ESA Compliance, and Management Actions: Budget Item C.4

Science Advisors FY18-20 TWP

- Standing Panel
- Independent Review Panel(s)
- Knowledge Assessment (3-year process)
- Routine Interactions with Reclamation, GCMRC, TWG, AMWG
- Routine Administration
- Budget: \$150,000/year + CPI

Standing Panel Purposes

- Provide routine independent ("neutral party") feedback during lead-up to next TWP, on:
 - Annual Reporting Meeting findings
 - Annual work plans
 - Knowledge Assessment findings (in FY 2020)
 - Draft TWP (in FY 2020)
- Provide recommendations for organizing and recruiting experts for independent external reviews (see below)

Standing Panel: FY18 Actions

- Develop charter and protocols
 - EC to develop in consultation with Reclamation, GCMRC, TWG, and AMWG
 - Charter and protocols to be based on DOI/AMWGapproved procedures pre-FY15
- Recruit and initiate first panel in time for 1/18 ARM

Independent Review Panels

- A "tool" provided to AMP in 1996 ROD
- Topic-specific reviews and advice
- TWP provides for 1-2 IRPs over next three years
- Identifying/selecting topics:
 - AMWG Action Items
 - ... and/or identified in consultation with Reclamation, GCMRC, TWG, and AMWG
 - May be suggested by controversies over TWP
- Panel procedures to follow pre-FY15 DOI/AMWGapproved procedures + OMB peer review guidelines
