#### **DOI** Guidance to AMWG

- DOI, through the Secretary's Designee, provides guidance to the AMWG at regularly scheduled AMWG meetings
- Secretary's Designee guides AMWG to focus on specific issues of importance as they become a higher priority.
- Secretary's Designee approves meeting agendas ensuring time is focused on issues of priority.

#### LTEMP ROD commitments

- Update GCDAMP guiding documents
  - Work group including AMWG members and DOI representatives
  - Target completion: end of FY 2019
- Develop monitoring metrics
  - Work group including GCMRC scientists, TWG members, and DOI representatives
  - Target completion: end of FY 2019

#### LTEMP ROD

- In developing the LTEMP EIS, DOI identified 8 objectives and 11 resource goals to improve resources within the Colorado River Ecosystem through experimental and management actions.
- These objectives and resource goals were considered in the formulation and development of alternatives in the EIS, and the decision to select Alternative D in the ROD.
