FY21-23 Budget Development Approach

- Start w/ 2018-2020 TWP
- Assume funding flat at FY19/FY20 level
- Prioritize DOI guidance and LTEMP goals
- Incorporate stakeholder input
- Strategize for Uncertainty

Identify tasks that are:

- Scalable or readily consolidated
- Time-sensitive (near-term, frequent, condition dependent)
- Address critical knowledge gaps
- Present High/Low Compliance Risk

- Total Annual Budget = \$11.36M
 - o 80% GCMRC = \$9,088,000
 - o 20% Reclamation = \$2,272,000

- Administrative History Project completed
- Reduced FY21 budget for B.4 -TWG Chair from \$25K to \$0

 - New C.12 Monitoring Metrics and Resource Condition Tracking
 - New C.13 Program Management (Project management, model assessment, streamlining guidance documents)

- Continue to explore internship and outreach opportunities to engage Tribal youth, possibly through Element D.2
- Continued support for implementation of 2017 PA elements including Cultural Sensitivity Training, Tribal Resources Monitoring, Archeological Monitoring and the NHPA Section 106 contingency fund
