


- 1. Describe linkages, sequences, and feedback loops among projects

 - 4. Continue to include active participation by GCMRC staff and any additional expertise.
 - 5. Incorporate comments from the Science Advisors. The TWG will include a response to comments document in their final draft.

Goal and Objective


Revise HBCCP to:

- Integrate plan actions
 - Be more prescriptive (priorities, timeline)
 - crises criteria
 - Integrates with the other plans (CMP, RP, etc.)
 - Work closely with SA s and GCMRC (SPG) to complete revised plan concurrent with other plans (late 2005/early 2006)
 - Will not look at in/out issue; HBCCP implementation ad hoc (AMWG) will adress this

Progress as of Today

- 3 conference calls and 1 meeting
 - Reviewed progress on original plan
 - Advised GCMRC and BAHG on HBC project funding in 2006 budget
 - Retain \$50 K for translocations
 - Retain \$25 K for dam operations
 - Retain \$200 K of BR dollars for TCD research
