#### Tribal Participation Funding for Glen Canyon Dam Adaptive Management Program

#### Background

1992 Public Law 102-575 The Grand Canyon Protection Act enables creation of Grand Canyon Adaptive Management Program (GCAMP), requiring an Adaptive Management Work Group Federal Advisory Committee made up of stakeholders including Tribal Nations: Navajo, Hopi, Pueblo of Zuni, Southern Paiute Consortium, and the Hualapai, regarding dam operations to protect the environmental resources of the Grand Canyon.

1999 Budget Established a reimbursable support agreement (RSA) for tribal participation in the GCDAMP, allows the five AMP member Tribes to participate in annual meetings for the Adaptive Management Work Group, Technical Work Group, and cultural resources. This budget item provides funds to identify traditional cultural properties (TCPs) and implement Native American monitoring protocols that were developed in FY 2007 and recommended by the TWG as part of efforts to develop a core-monitoring program

\$95,000 annually for each of five tribes

- \$80,000 to cover salaries, benefits and per diem
- \$15,000 to an annual river monitoring trip.

#### Additional Funding since 1999

- 2011 Agreement increases by providing up to \$35,000 (\$35K x 5 = \$175k) more for annual monitoring
- 2017 LTEMP Agreement (20 years in 5 year agreements, end 2037)

#### Tribal requests for action

Increase participation budget, no adjustment for inflation in twenty-three years.

#### Problem Statement

Annual participation budgets have not been fully spent and showing unexpended funding does not support justification of increase of annual budget
