Section 106 of the NHPA

- LTEMP has an existing Programmatic Agreement for adverse effects to historic properties.
- Under this agreement, there are stipulations that Reclamation must fulfill before LTEMP expires.
- Some are ongoing like river monitoring support for Hopi, Hualapai, Navajo, NPS, Southern Paiute Consortium, and Zuni.
- Others are singular events write a report on HFE effects.
- This week: Annual Meeting.



Status of LTEMP

• Annual Meeting for cultural resources concluded yesterday.

- River Monitoring recommendations; We will have a new meeting associated with Fall TWG to review recommendations from the monitoring trips & provide NPS with data earlier for planning purposes.
- HFEs and Archaeological sites Helen Fairley and Joel Sanskey shared their insights into wind-borne sediment movements.
- LiDAR Helen and Joel talked about using LiDAR to record petroglyphs. The group was enthusiastic about this project.
- Jamesita Peshlakai shared her efforts over the last year in helping projects advance, coordinate meetings, and the importance of communication.



Status of LTEMP

Cultural Sensitivity Update

- Reclamation changed course on how to proceed with the Cultural Sensitivity Training stipulated in the LTEMP PA.
- Rather than using a 3rd Party negotiator, Reclamation and GCMRC will help the Hopi, Hualapai, Navajo, Southern Paiute Consortium, and Zuni work on presentations as a demonstration of individual cultural sensitivity trainings and then refine them.
- Tribal Project Updates
 - Projects under D6-D12 are ongoing.



Some Action Items

- Communication to respond with receipt of message and timeframe to get back to sender about issues (close the blackhole)
 - Response: Ongoing effort. Some improvement over last year.
- Tribal names for locations and which Tribal language for which name.
 - Future discussion.
- Early consultation on high flow experiments
 - Response: I will send out notifications EARLY to alert people.
- Additional meeting at Fall TWG; Send out meeting notes.
- Specific timeline for Cultural Sensitivity Actions.
 - Meet in 3 weeks to discuss specifics.
