NEW ACTION ITEMS

- Re-engage the SBAHG to review and update the Nonnative Strategic Plan and also begin to evaluate new management actions for the short-, medium-, and long-term management actions.
- Re-engage the SEAHG as part of an effort to evaluate current hydropower modeling and recommend a potential hydropower experiment, similar to the TAHG's charge.

OLD ACTION ITEMS – Still Open

- NOV 2023 Helen Fairley (GCMRC) Provide the LTEMP metrics report for review by TWG. They put this aside during the TWP process. They have reconnected with Reclamation and will provide an update at the Feb meeting.
- JULY 2025 Review the Nonnative Strategic Plan and determine whether the SBAHG needs a charge to address any outstanding items in the document.
- JULY 2025 Explore how risk tolerance may be incorporated in risk assessment or other decision-making processes.
- DECEMBER 2025 Consider organizing a facilitated workshop to discuss long-term strategies for non-native fish management. – SBAHG Chair and Reclamation coordination to find an appropriate venue
- APRIL 2026 Consider using the SCAHG and TWG to explore options for proactive planning.
- APRIL 2026 Explore whether the TWG needs to inform the AMWG on information needed for the Glen Canyon Dam Report to Congress.
