By consensus vote, (16 – Yays, 0 – Nays, and 4 – Absents) the Glen Canyon Dam Technical Work Group (TWG) has adopted the below motion and attached documents to be sent to the Glen Canyon Dam Adaptive Management Work Group to be considered for adoption into the Glen Canyon Adaptive Management Program on August 12-13, 2026:

“The Technical Work Group (TWG) recommends that the Adaptive Management Work Group approve and forward to the Secretary of the Interior the attached FY27 Bureau of Reclamation and Grand Canyon Monitoring and Research Center budget scenarios, recognizing that they represent an attempt to address potential funding reductions while maintaining support for critical monitoring, research, data management capacity, and Glen Canyon Dam Adaptive Management Program obligations.

The TWG further recommends that any unforeseen available funding be used to address ongoing or emerging threats and to preserve previously planned research and monitoring activities.”
