Management Objective 41

Current level: 264 Register eligible historic properties

Under MO 41 make distinction between traditional cultural properties (tcps) and archaeological/historic properties.

Target level will be defined by the research design – which is currently out for bid through an RFP.

Change Action in MO 41 from “preserve” to “treat.”

Qualitative Target for MO 41 – “For purpose of federal agency compliance (BOR, NPS, and GCMRC) with Section 106 and 110 of the National Historic Preservation Act and the AMP/AMWG compliance with the Grand Canyon Protection Act.”

MO 41 – Action: Preserve via protection, manage, and/or treat

Management Objective 42

MO 42 – Grand Canyon Protection Act compliance issue. Comment: delete “cultural” from element section.

- SWCA synthesis identified only a minimum number of resources – just for plants and springs.

Qualitative target for MO 41 – 1. Preserving: based on current cultural value – stabilize or improve.
2. purpose is to preserve (stabilize or improve based on current cultural value) other traditionally important resources that are not sufficiently addressed under other MOs.

Management Objective 43

MO 43 – Need to define Management Action.

Element change to “Research, Monitoring, and Management Actions.”
