

Comments on FY 2003 Work Plans:

- 1 PA budget should be needs-based
- 2 Total of monitoring and treatment (PA) should be lumped (\$240,000) due to lack of monitoring research design plan
- 3 budget ad hoc committee should address 2003 budget
- 4 Cultural monitoring should not be reduced without a monitoring plan
- 5 We should establish a contingency fund for data recovery
- 6 Fix 2<sup>nd</sup> sentence in footnote #14
- 7 Monitoring required even with treatment
- 8 Distribute monitoring reports from tribal monitoring trips to the TWG
- 9 WAPA wants CRSP revenues tied to monitoring and research program / ESA & NHPA - Budget Ad Hoc to address
- 10 Should not cut long-term monitoring program if appropriations do not materialize
- 11 Tribal monitoring (PA & terrestrial) should be combined
- 12 Tribal terrestrial monitoring activities differ from tribal river trips.
- 13 Detailed work plan should address links between tribal participation and resource monitoring
- 14 Redefinition of APE key to identifying register eligible properties (106 v. 110)
- 15 Cultural resources data management → no agreement yet reached on transferring data base to GCMRC
- 16 Holecene mapping to follow geomorphological workshop
- 17 Rotation of tribal interns
- 18 Budget Ad Hoc Group meet prior to next TWG meeting
- 19 Need actual budget for 2001
