Basin Hydrology (Attachment 1): Randy Peterson reported that most of the Basin is in the 80-90% range for precipitation. If more precipitation occurs, it will not change the hydrology much. The forecast dropped yesterday again to 80% of normal; that is down from 87% of normal on Feb 1, 1999. Lake elevation: 3678; 21.8 MAF, which is about as low as it will go this year.

1998-1999 Releases: The proposal is to decrease to an average of 11,000-12,000 cfs throughout the spring. Maximum daily fluctuations will be 6,000 cfs rather than 8,000 cfs. Lake Powell is expected to be not less than 8 feet from full at its fullest point. **1999 Releases:** To benefit downstream resources, spring releases will be a little higher than expected in a minimum release year.
