Items:

Yampa headwaters are responding well. Possibly more mid elevation snow available. Warmer temperatures forecast through the weekend.

Tom – drop early next week driven by cooling?

Greg – Cooling and loss of snowpack responsible

Matt/Randy – Opened outlet gate yesterday, raised wetland elevation. Light traps contained 8 larvae this morning captured in Stuart Lake. Increased flows may put more water into Stuart, through the 29th.

Kevin – could Reclamation send more water to extend flows around 11,000 cfs Jerry – Amount of water to be released probably could be better used to prop baseflows Extended flows from bypass unlikely to reach elevation reached without bypass

Recovery program likely to put request to Reclamation on record to increase flows possibly on Memorial Day.
