## Navajo Dam Road Closure

May 14, 2024

New Mexico Highway 539 over Navajo Dam, located about 45 miles east of Farmington, New Mexico, will reopen to traffic on the evening of Wednesday, May 15. Drilling will continue on other areas of the dam through the summer until the fall when drilling resumes on Highway 539 and Highway 511 for the Fall 2024 through Spring 2025 seasons.
