Minidoka Irrigation District (MID) is a Bureau of Reclamation irrigation district that serves approximately 13,000 water users with 502 miles of canals, laterals, and drainage systems. MID receives storage water from the Minidoka, American Falls, Palisades, and Jackson Dams. The District has functioned for many years without the necessary upgrades for the present and future needs of the District's customers. MID is therefore working towards a more efficient system. MID has a Water Conservation Plan in place.


We are applying for a grant from the Bureau of Reclamation to help with the expenses associated with piping the Lower C2 lateral. The reason for the pipe line is to eliminate the water lost through seepage, rodent and varmint holes along with run over issues caused by fluctuating in water levels while water users are moving wheel lines. These problems have caused us to lose 15 percent of our water volume.


We are unable put roads on the lateral due to a farmer's main line on the west side which runs along the toe of the lateral and powerlines on the east side of the lateral. The ditch runs north and south parallel to a state highway and the borrow pit is usually so soft from the seepage that it could be a safety issue if someone traveling the highway happened to catch the edge and pull them into either the lateral or a power pole. There is also a safety concern when we are fixing the problems along the lateral, with our machines along a busy highway whose speed limit is 55 mph. We also had a problem last year with water running into the farmer's field. This ended up with the farmer having to file two claims against (MID) due to crop damage. The project's plan is to pipe 1,760 feet with 24 inch 80 psi. We are planning to put a concrete box that is 4x4x8 at the end of the pipe line to keep it the same level as the existing lateral. At the head of the pipe line, we are planning to put a new 24 inch head gate, with a new concrete 4x6 wall which will include attached wing walls to prevent wash outs around the wall in the future, plus a 6x6 floor to give the wall a strong foundation as well as stop erosion at the bottom of the new installation. The new concrete box at the tail end of the pipe line will include a 15 inch gate and an 18 inch to deliver water to the downstream water users. The farmer whose property this will cross is willing to help participate in the project as well.






Top View Beginning of Pipe Line
